Directions to the St. Paul Campus

Gillette is located on the third and fourth floors of Regions Hospital and in a building connected by skyway. Regions Hospital sits at the corner of Jackson Street and University Avenue in St. Paul (just west of 35E and north of 94).

To enter Gillette, take the North Elevators in the Regions Hospital West Ramp. (See below for directions to ramp.) To find Gillette Surgery and third-floor services, the James R. Gage Center for Gait and Motion Analysis, and Rehabilitation Therapies, see Page 2.

From the north

Roseville, White Bear Lake, North St. Paul, Duluth, etc.
Take 35E south to University Avenue exit. Turn right onto
University Avenue (bottom of ramp). Drive two blocks; turn
left onto Jackson Street at light. Take first left to the Regions
Hospital West Ramp, level D.

From the south

Eagan, Mendota Heights, Burnsville, etc.

Take 35E north to 11th Street exit. Continue ahead to the Jackson Street intersection. Turn left onto Jackson Street. Take the second right to the Regions Hospital West Ramp, level D.

From the east

Wisconsin, Woodbury, etc.

Take 94 west to 12th Street/Capitol exit. At the stoplight, turn right onto Jackson Street. Take second right to the Regions Hospital West Ramp, level D.

From the west

Minneapolis

Take 94 east to Marion Street exit. Turn left onto Marion Street; drive past Sears store. Turn right onto University Avenue; drive four blocks to Jackson Street. Turn right onto Jackson Street. Take first left to the Regions Hospital West Ramp, level D.

From the southeast

Inver Grove Heights, Cottage Grove, South St. Paul, etc.
Take Hwy. 52 north until it becomes a city street, Lafayette
Road. Continue north to the stoplight at the University Avenue
intersection. Turn left onto University Avenue. Continue to
the stoplight at the Jackson Street intersection. Turn left onto
Jackson Street. Take first left to the Regions Hospital West
Ramp, level D.

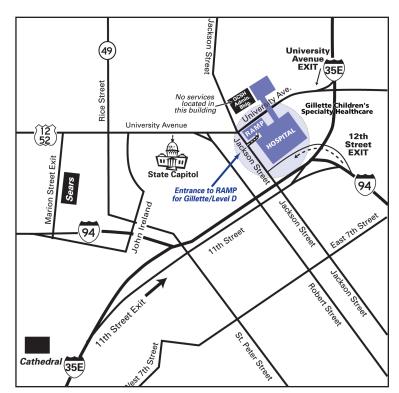
From the southwest

Eden Prairie, Bloomington, etc.

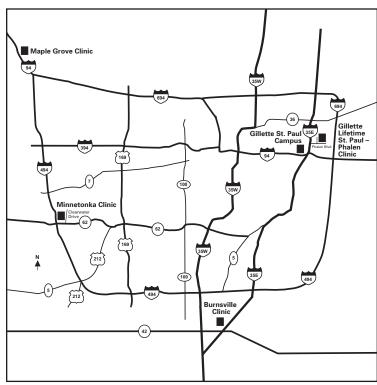
Take 494 east to 35E north. Take 35E north to 11th Street exit. Continue ahead to the Jackson Street intersection. Turn left onto Jackson Street. Take the second right to the Regions Hospital West Ramp, level D.

From the St. Paul-Phalen Clinic to the St. Paul campus

From Cayuga Street, turn right on Phalen Boulevard. Cross the bridge and continue to L'Orient Street. Turn left and follow L'Orient Street to University Avenue. Turn right on University Avenue, then turn left on Jackson Street. Turn left to enter the Regions Hospital West Ramp.

Parking

Patients and families should park in the West Ramp, which is connected to Regions Hospital. Its entrance is on Jackson Street.

Valet Parking

Weekdays from 8:30 to 5:30, we offer complimentary valet parking for Gillette patients and families. (Although the valet service is free, parking ramp fees still apply.) Pull up to the main Gillette entrance (level D of the Regions Hospital West Ramp). After unloading, give your vehicle's keys to the valets. They will give you a claim ticket and park your vehicle for you. If needed, they will help you unload and show you to the registration area. When you're ready to leave, give your claim ticket to the valets, and they will bring your vehicle to you.

Tall Vehicles

If your vehicle is taller than 7 feet, please go to the main entrance to Regions Hospital (off Jackson Street). Use the valet parking. If you have Gillette stamp your valet ticket, the cost for valet parking is the same as the cost for parking in the Regions Hospital West Ramp.

Accessible Parking

All of the parking spots on Level D are large enough for wheelchair-accessible vans. Additional patient parking is available on Levels C, E and F. Those levels have accessible parking spaces near the hospital entrances, but the spaces aren't large enough for wheelchair-accessible vans. You must have an accessibility (handicap) sticker to park on Level D or in any of the other accessible spaces.

Parking Rates

To receive a reduced parking rate for patients and families, simply bring your parking ticket to the main desk in any Gillette department. We'll stamp your ticket.

To Find Gillette's Main Entrance

The main entrance to Gillette is on Level D of the Regions Hospital West Ramp. If you park on another level, please take the North Elevators to the fourth floor to enter Gillette. The North Elevators are located at the east end of the parking ramp. Most appointments take place on our fourth floor. If your appointment is on our third floor, it will say so in your appointment letter.

To Find Surgery and Third-Floor Services

Surgery, Advanced Imaging Services and some outpatient appointments are located on the third floor. To reach these areas, take the North Elevators to the third floor and turn left to enter Gillette.

To Find the Center for Gait and Motion Analysis

Take the North Elevators to the fourth floor, and register at the main desk. Then follow the fourth-floor skyway to Gillette's new patient-care building. Note: The only entrance to the new building is through the skyway. There's no street access.

The skyway is just past the North Elevators and Ginkgo Coffee Bar and Deli. Follow the skyway past the entrance to Rehabilitation Therapies and turn right. Follow the corridor to the elevators on the left. Take the elevator to ground level.

To Find Rehabilitation Therapies

Take the North Elevators to the fourth floor, and register at the main desk. Then follow the fourth-floor skyway to Gillette's new patient-care building. Note: The only entrance to the new building is through the skyway. There's no street access.

The skyway is just past the North Elevators and Ginkgo Coffee Bar and Deli. The entrance to Rehabilitation Therapies is on the right, near the north end of the skyway.
